Getting Started


Go to: https://www.pichit.org/reports

The following window will appear on your screen.




Enter your user name and password and click "OK".


You will be brought to the SQL Server Reporting Services home page as shown below.




Click on the link entitled "Measures". You will now see the following:



If you click on the link entitled "M2 Diabetes" you will see the following:




If you click on the double pointed arrow as indicated you can expand the window as shown below.




Generating Reports

Now, let's explore the different field options.


As you can see here, the first field listed in the top left hand corner is "Report Period Begin". If you were to click on the calendar icon, a calendar would appear allowing you to choose the month, day, and year.




The functionality is the same for the field "Report Period End".




Now let's click on the down arrow for the field "Practice." This is what you would see.



Let's check the "Select All" box.




If you were to click on the "View Report" button, this is what you would see:




For the "Practice" field the report manager will generate a report for each health center separately. The fields "Ethnicity" and "Gender" had multiple fields listed and are included in the report.


Click on "Waimanalo Health Center" to view a report of M2 Diabetes of patients from Waimanalo Health Center. You will notice below that the report includes both genders and all ethnicities that were listed in the respective drop-down lists.



Now let's generate a report selecting "Chinese" from the "Ethnicity" drop-down list.




Click the "View Report" button to generate the report as shown below.




Now let's run a report to determine the percentage of Native Hawaiian male patients seen in the ER with low complexity problems at Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center (WCCHC) from January 1, 2008 to March 31, 2008.

Click on "M4(a)(b) ER Use Encounters" on the Measures page.




For **Report Period Begin** type 1/1/2008 and for **Report Period End** type 3/31/2008. For **HealthPlan** select AlohaCare. For **Practice** select WCCHC. For **Gender** select Male. For **Ethnicity** select Native Hawaiian. For **Report Subtype** select 4a.


Click the View Report button.



This is what you should see.




If you scroll to the very bottom of the report you will see that 16.51% Native Hawaiian male patients were seen in the ER with low complexity problems at Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center (WCCHC) from January 1, 2008 to March 31, 2008.




Exporting Reports to Other Formats

If you click on the downward arrow in the "Select a format" drop-down list, you will see that you can export reports to different formats.




Comparative Dashboard

Click on the "Comparative Dashboard" link on the "Measures" page.




Select the "Report Month Begin" and "Report Month End".




Click the "View Report" button to generate the report.

Subscriptions


To create a new subscription click on "New Subscription" found on the measures page.
