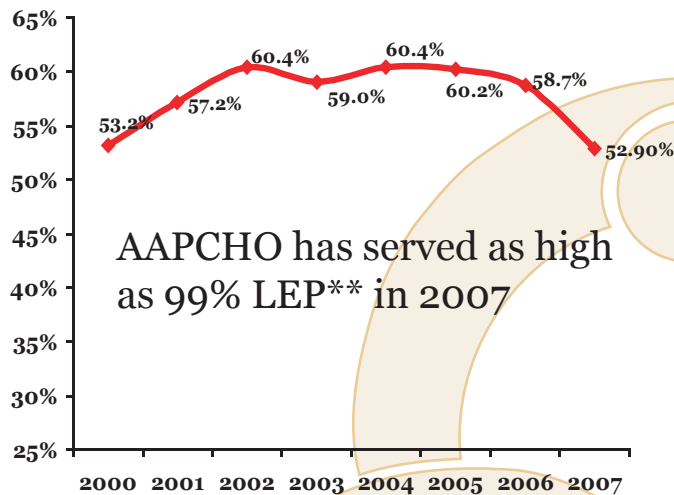


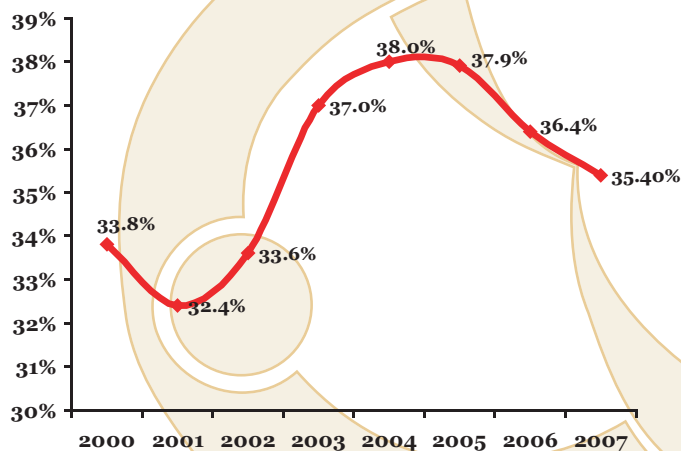

Compared with the National Average Bureau of Primary Health Care Federally Qualified Health Center, the Average AAPCHO Center has:

- Higher proportion of visits/year for health conditions:
Asthma, Hypertension, Diabetes, Otitis Media, Mental Disorder
- Higher proportion of LEP patients
- Higher proportion of geriatric patients
- Poorer patients (100% and below Federal Poverty Level)

AAPCHO Demographic Summary for 2007 (19 Sites)

- Racial/Ethnic Minorities: 80%, including 162,129 Asians, 21,796 Native Hawaiians, & 24,780 Other Pacific Islanders
- Limited English Proficiency: 53% or 170,941
- Income at or Below 100% Poverty: 74% or 195,119
- Uninsured: 35% or 114,304
- Medicaid Coverage: 40% or 129,168
